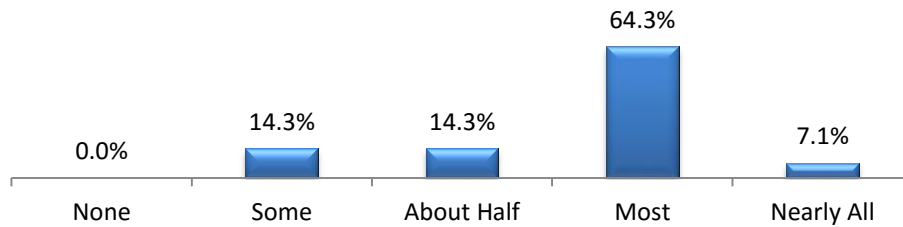

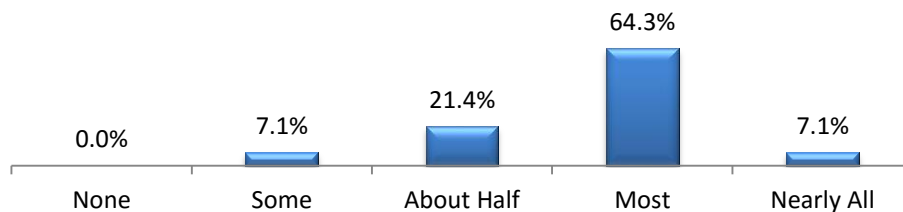
How many staff in this school feel good about parents' support for their work?



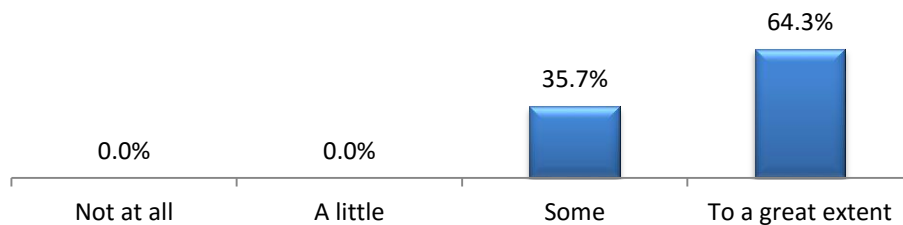
How many parents support your teaching efforts?



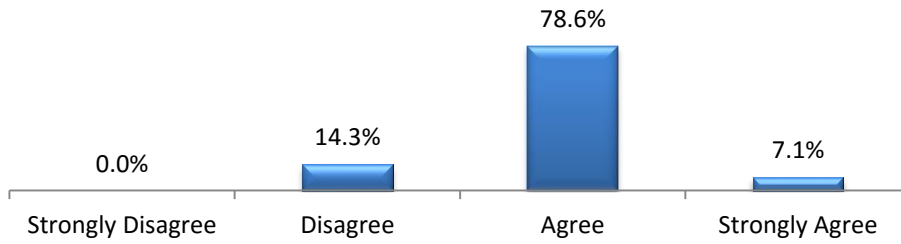
How many parents do their best to help their children learn?



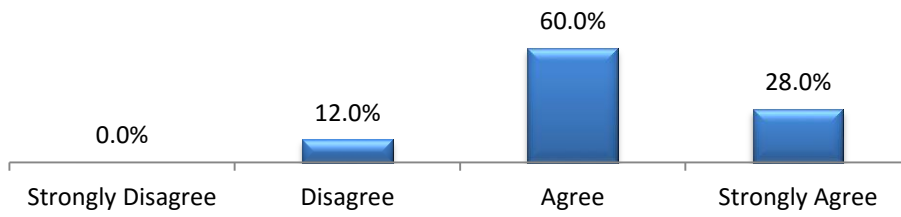
To what extent do you feel respected by the parents of your students?



Teachers and parents think of each other as partners in educating children.



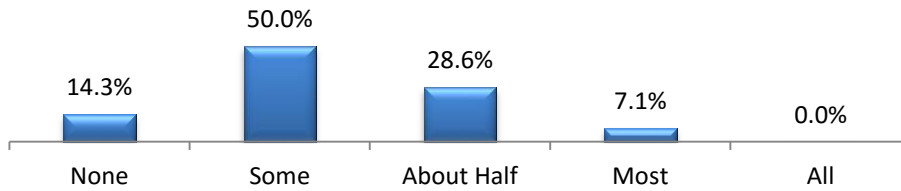
Staff at this school work hard to build trusting relationships with parents.



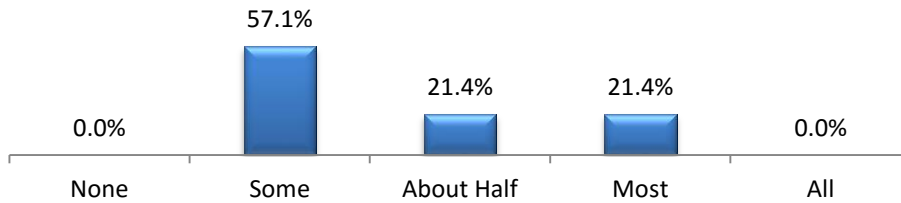

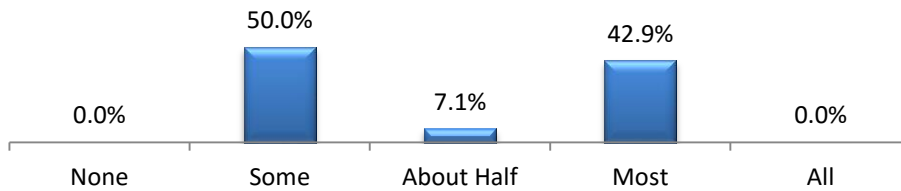

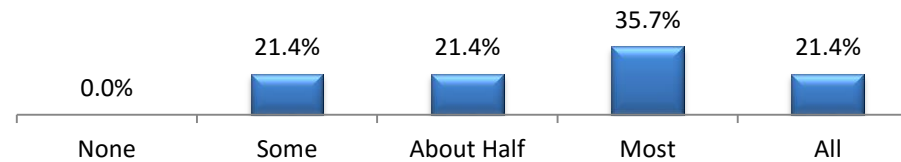

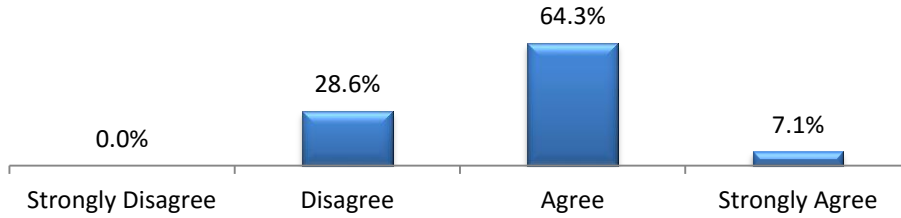

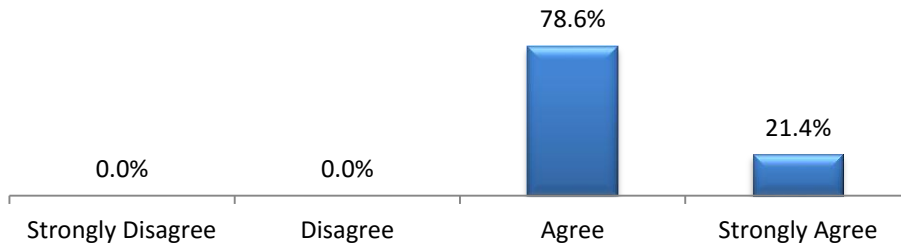
Teachers work closely with parents to meet students' needs.



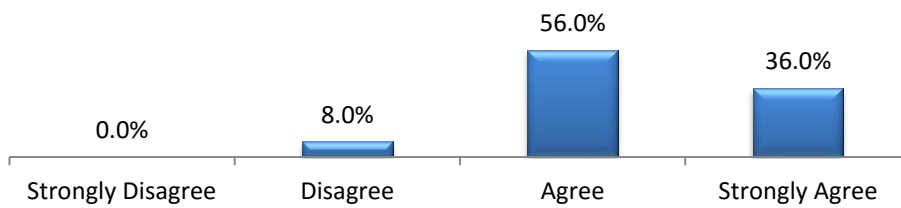
The principal pushes teachers to communicate regularly with parents.



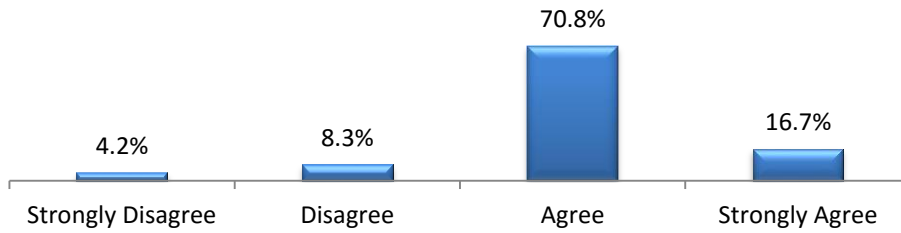
Teachers really try to understand parents' problems and concerns.



Parents are greeted warmly when they call or visit the school.

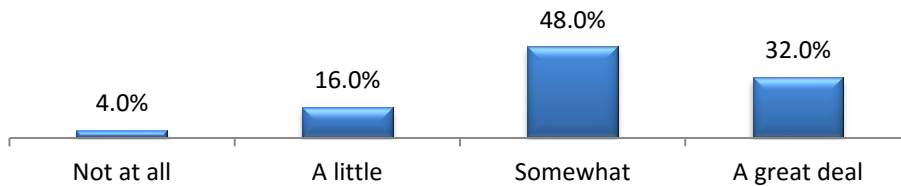

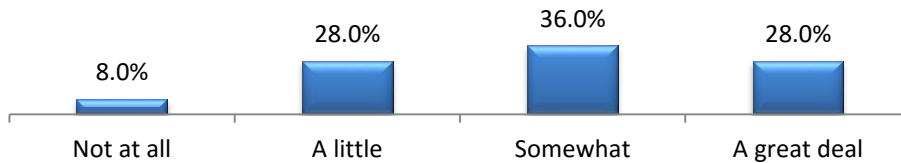

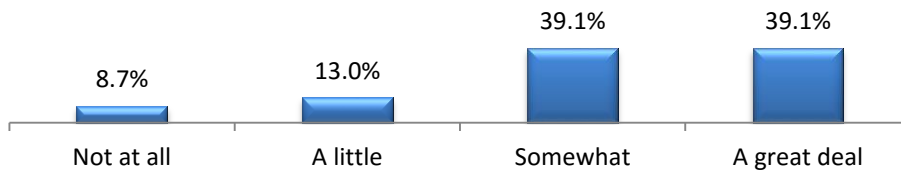
Involve parents in the development of programs aimed at improving students' academic outcomes?



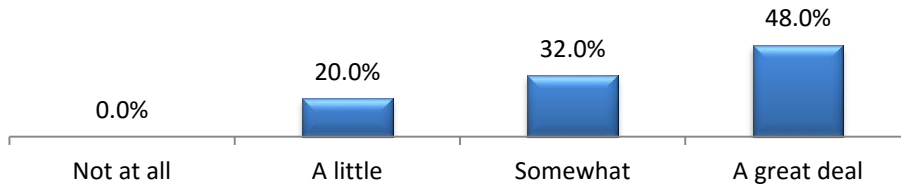
Involve parents in commenting on school curricula?



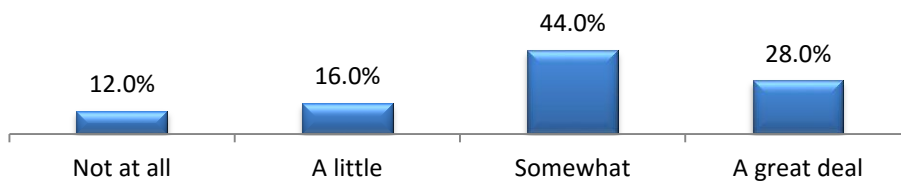
Include parent leaders from all backgrounds in school improvement?
